

## Gold Conversion workshop instructor selection criteria

- 1. Be a current registered Provider, or working for a Corporate Provider
- 2. Be currently delivering Bronze, Silver and Gold courses (minimum per year: 1 of each level, or equivalent)
- 3. Be a current Tutor Course Director (minimum 1 course per year)
- 4. Hold a higher NGB qualification as per Tutors Award Directorship
- 5. Be invited to become so by the Board (numbers of Gold Conversion Workshop Providers required nationally to be agreed by the Board)
- 6. Agree to Provider Terms and, importantly, understand that the maximum required number of Gold workshop instructors nationally is currently 3
- 7. Understand that the Gold Conversion workshop is run under the NNAS brand only, they are not devolved. It must be emphasised that when delivering these workshops, the instructor is representing NNAS and not their own organisation
- 8. Workshops dates are determined by collaboration between NNAS and the workshop instructor, and then advertised and administrated by NNAS via the CMS
