2023 Provider Survey report

The Provider survey was carried out in February 2023. It focused on the Navigator awards. A separate set of discussions were had between the ODA Providers.

In the nearly 30 years since the NNAS was launched at the Royal Institute of Navigation in 1994 this is the first attempt to survey the award Providers. Much has changed in that time from digitised customer management systems to a full-time staffed office, and training for all tutors. The outdoor sector has also developed numerous qualifications which can work with the NNAS awards, and the various associations have developed CPD policies and regionalisation governance which NNAS is also pursuing...*to read more click [here!](#)*
